China Visa Policy:

Certain countries, including Singapore, Brunei, Japan, France, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands, Spain, and Malaysia, have visa-free policies for ordinary passport holders. Citizens of these countries traveling to China for business, tourism, visiting relatives and friends, or transit for up to 15 days can enter China without a visa. However, for travelers from countries not listed above, a China visa is required. We offer support for obtaining a China visa for participants from these countries.
