Language Requirements

The course is taught in Chinese, but we have English-Chinese bilingual assistants available for complex terms. If you speak a different language, make sure to bring a Wi-Fi-enabled device and translation apps.

Course Session Length

You can choose your session length during the summer camp (June 5 – September 5, 2025). A typical session lasts 12 days, with 7 days of classes and 5 optional days for ceramic museum tours.

Class Size and Participants

- Group size: 10 people or more
- Minimum participants: 5
- Teens under 18 must attend with parents or teachers
- Adults 18+ can join independently
- No experience required; beginners and amateurs are welcome

Living Arrangements

Accommodation is usually arranged within walking distance from the teaching studios.

Calligraphy Class FAQ

I don't understand Chinese. Can I still join the workshop?

Yes! Our workshop is taught in both Mandarin and English, so even if you don't speak Chinese, you'll be able to follow along. The materials will be in English, and we'll make sure everything is easy to understand.

I'm not in JingDeZhen. Can I still join the workshop?

Currently, we only offer in-person workshops, so you would need to travel to JingDeZhen to join. We recommend planning your visit for a truly immersive experience!

I'm a complete beginner. Will this workshop be too advanced for me?

Not at all! Our workshop is designed for beginners. We'll start slow and build up your skills step by step. You don't need any prior experience—just bring your enthusiasm!

Can I get personal feedback on my work?

Yes! We encourage you to send us your practice pieces after your first session, and we'll provide feedback and tips to help you improve before moving on to the next lesson.

Are materials provided in the course?

Yes, we provide a standard material kit at the start of the workshop. If you need extra supplies, you can buy them separately.

Can I learn at my own pace?

Absolutely! Our live class will go at a comfortable pace for everyone, but you'll also have access to the class replay for a month, so you can go over any parts you want to practice more.

What's the IMPROVER level?

Our IMPROVER workshops are for those who already have basic calligraphy skills. These classes will help you refine your technique, improve your script, and add flourishes to your work. If you've been practicing for a little while, this level is for you!

Is there an age limit?

We welcome students aged 7 and up. If you're under 18, you'll need to be accompanied by a parent or guardian or teacher.

What's the practice content for Chinese calligraphy?

We cover several styles of calligraphy, such as Regular Script (楷书), Clerical Script (隶书), and Running Script (行书). The content may vary depending on how long you stay in China.

When will I receive a certificate?

You'll receive a certificate after completing all the courses and passing the final exam.

How is the accommodation?

We can provide information on accommodations in Jingdezhen. Check the [Lodging in Jingdezhen page] for details.

What about daily necessities?
