### ASEAN Multi-Year Business Visa

This is not a visa-free policy, but a special multi-entry visa:

- Countries: Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Brunei, Vietnam, Laos, Myanmar, Cambodia, and East Timor
- Type: Business visa (not visa-free)
- Stay: Up to 3 months per visit, valid up to 5 years
- Eligible Family: Spouse and children of applicant

### Important Notes

- Most other nationalities still need a visa to enter China.
- Visa-free stays cannot be extended or converted to another visa once in China.
- Visa-free entry is usually for tourism, business, family visits, or transit only.
