4. Guomao Plaza (Huayang, Jinchangli, Jinghan) – Over 90 acres of ceramic shops
5. Ceramic Expo City (Taobo City) – Opened 2023, modern trading hub and venue for the China Ceramic Expo

Featured Flea & Creative Markets

- Taoxichuan Ceramic Market – Night flea market, 80% original works
- Sculpture Factory Market – Historic industrial site, strong in sculpture and creative ceramics
- Dongshi Flea Market – Near Ceramic University; young designers and emerging artists
- Sanbao International Ceramic Valley Market – Resident artist stalls, popular with tourists
