## Q1. Who can apply?

Teacher-led groups of 2–10 students, aged 15+, are welcome. Each group must be accompanied by a supervising teacher.

## Q2. How long is the program?

Standard duration is 1–2 weeks, but we can adjust based on your school's vacation schedule.

#### O3. What does the fee include? What fee excluded?

Application Fee: \$150 per student (non-refundable). Housing & Studio Access: custom arrangements based on group size and schedule. Living Cost: approx. \$100 per week. Travel, personal expenses, and optional cultural tours are not included.

#### O4. What courses will students take?

Students participate in hands-on workshops such as pottery wheel throwing, hand-building, ceramic painting, pottery decoration, and Chinese calligraphy.

## Q5. Do students need prior ceramics experience?

No. The program welcomes all levels — beginners and advanced art students alike.

#### Q6. What optional activities are available?

Groups may add cultural excursions (extra cost): Imperial Kiln Museum & Taoyang Alley, Ancient Kiln Folk Museum, Sanbao International Ceramic Valley, Taoxichuan Art Market, Yaoli Ancient Town, China Ceramic Expo.

## Q7. How safe is Jingdezhen for students?

Jingdezhen is a student-friendly city with affordable transport (taxis from \$1, bikes & scooters common) and a vibrant yet safe art community.

#### Q8. What is the application process?

1. Fill out the online form and pay the application fee. 2. Submit group information and teacher details. 3. Provide student list and proof of enrollment. Invitation letters and visa support will be issued after approval.

#### Q9. Cancellation Policy

Tour payments are non-refundable if cancellation is made within 4 weeks of your scheduled arrival. However, the full amount can be credited toward a future trip to Jingdezhen.
